Introduction to the subject

This is a two-year course suitable for keen beginners, especially if they are studying another foreign language. Qualifications in modern languages, especially Spanish, are increasingly highly valued by employers and Russell Group universities. The course is an excellent basis for moving on to study AS/A-level Spanish.

Assessment

Exam.

Students will be entered for the Foundation or Higher Tier based on their performance during the 2 year programme.

Reading	Unit 3	15% exam
Writing	Unit 4	40% exam
